

Club Firearms

As you know, the club has a selection of firearms/ammunition for members to use at the range. I'm sure you'll appreciate that this involves a bit of extra work for some members. Apart from a few firearms, most are rarely used. In future, CR&GC will operate the following policy. This will be subject to periodic review and is dependent on the firearm keepers being able to attend.

A page identifying individual firearms is on the Programme tab of the website.

Policy

On range days, only certain firearms will be taken as a matter of course. Any other firearm/ammunition will only be taken at the request of a member. The request must be made to the secretary, giving at least two days' notice.

For competitions, depending on likely attendance on Dutyman, other FTR/TR may be taken but best if a request is made for a specific firearm.

Short and Long Range Days

.303 Lee Enfield No4

.308 BSA FTR-A (Athlon Scope) or .308 BSA FTR-B (Bushnell Scope) if DD not attending

.303 & .308 ammunition

Gallery Days

.44 BP Revolver

.357 Henry

.22 Ruger

.22 Marlin

.22/.357/.38 ammunition - there *may* be a limited amount of .303/.308 but no guarantee.
