

## Range Setup ([gallery range extras in blue](#))

First member to arrive will fill in the Range Register with date and time.

In general, tasks to be done equipment needed are:

Flags, Target setup, RCO box, (targets for short range if necessary), mats.

Please write on the board who is doing what – times too for exterior flags!

### Flags from Cabin

Main Gate (including sign), West flag, Kennels (gate to be closed) and Farm Flag.

If shooting 500/600yds, 500yd flag and close gate. Track sign for 600yds only.

I suggest the same person or persons combine the West and Kennels, and another combines Main Gate and Farm.

### Flags from Butts

East (with gate closed), Range in Use. Also rig the Butts panel. [For gallery, Butts panel not required, but please fly Pistol Butts flag.](#)

Open butts, rig appropriate targets and set up electronics if you know how.

## Location of Flags

### Main Gate

As well as the flag, please fix the 'Range in Use' sign to the fittings on the post on the LHS (as you drive in) post. Don't forget to take it in when you collect the flag.

### Mains of Clunas Farm

This is a bit of a drive, but not too hard to find. Exit the range, turn right. Take the RH turning a couple of hundred yards along the road - signposted Dulsie Bridge. Continue along this road and turn right at the junction. Follow the road for a while and you will see a large blue sign for the Water Treatment Works on the RHS. Turn right at the sign and take the farm road. You'll pass the large farm buildings on your right and will see the flag-pole attached to the wooden sheep pens.

### Kennels

Exit the range, turn left and take the first left before crossing the bridge. Drive up until you see the buildings on the RHS. On the opposite side of the road, walk up the track, close the gate and raise the flag. Please open the gate when collecting the flag.

## West Flag

This can either be put out from the cabin or from the butts. The track up is passable - well I can get my Citroen up - and my personal choice would be from the cabin. Leave the range and follow instructions for the kennels. Drive past the kennels towards the small cottage. **Please drive slowly and watch out for small dogs!** The road turns to the left down a hill through some whins. Follow the track until you reach the deer fence. If locked, the combination is either our usual one or 1078. **We have been advised to close the gate, even if you find it open.** Continue along the road and up the steepish hill. You'll see the flagpole at the top. The gate is secured by a chain only and you can turn the car just past it.

If you are walking from the butts, then probably the best route is to follow the road until you get to the fence, then walk up the hill.

## Range In Use and East Flag

Both are stored in the butts. The first is flown on the pole directly behind the butts. Follow the track along from this and you'll see the East Flag's pole beside a gate. Close the gate when you raise the flag, and please remember to open it when collecting the flag.

## Pistol Range Flag

This is kept in the butts. It is only used when shooters are on the 50m range. It's flown from the pole at the top of the hill leading to the butts.

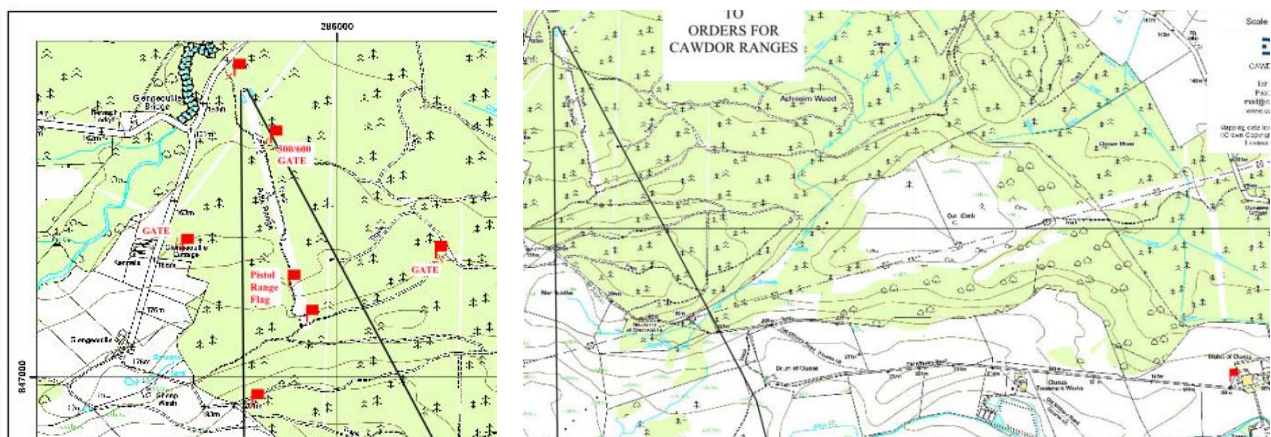
## 500yd flag

This is kept in the butts. The flag is raised and gate closed only when we are shooting from the 600yd point. The safety sign should also be deployed in the middle of the track before the steps up to the firing point. Sign should be collected and 500yd gate opened when shooting is completed.

## Carn Mao!

This flag is only needed on the rare occasions when we are not shooting prone. This is usually only the Service Rifle Competition. Access is past the water treatment tanks beyond Mains of Clunas.
